1. **The Old Duke**- Original rubber press from Moulton rubber factory
2. **Gold Postbox** – Local boy Ed Mckeever won a gold medal in the London 2012 Olympics. It was supposed to be painted red after 1 year, but the local residents kept painting it gold again; after a short while the council gave up trying to paint it red
3. **Witch's Cottage** – This crooked cottage is the most haunted house in Bradford-on-Avon. Local builders won't touch it. So it has remained the same since.
4. **Magic Frog** – On the side of one of the terrace houses of Middle Rank is a stone frog carved into the wall. It is difficult to find but the reward is huge. Rub the head of the frog and make a wish. You can find it on some steps going up the left hand side of a house.
5. **Mary Tory Chapel** – The views from the garden are great and you can see the Westbury White Horse in the distance on a clear day. There was once a hermit living under the chapel. Now it is just open for visitors. Pop inside and have a look; also keep an eye out for a geocache.
6. **Ladywell Spring** – This spring is a bit difficult to find! It is down a wobbly paved walkway snaking through some houses. It was once a natural source of water for the town, although I wouldn't suggest drinking it....
7. **The Spooky Bell** – At the bottom of the steps look up at the side of the building, you will see a bell at a jaunty angle. It is always stuck on the same angle, but every now and then it will ring 3 times but has never been seen to move! Hearing it is a bad omen in the town and suggests that something unwanted is about to happen in the town.
8. **The Saxon church** – The church of St Laurence was built in Saxon times and was a very important part of the town. Now it is opened and closed everyday by the residents of Church Street on a weekly rota.
9. **The Bridge Tea Rooms** – This is one of the oldest buildings in the town and plays host to a number of spectral beings. Pop in for tea and cakes; if you do, ask for Zarah and tell her that I sent you!
10. **Viewpoint** – In the car park of the Scout hut you can get a great view of all the terraces you just walked through. Keep an eye out for the windmill!
11. **The Lock Up** – You've probably noticed a funny looking building on the town bridge. This is the old lock up, they would lock up naughty children in there and still do to this day. Atop the lock up is a Golden Gudgeon, this legendary Fish can be found in the river by only the most eagle eyed children. Can you see it?
12. **This marks the end of the journey. Here you can get a great view of the bridge. It is also a great looking point for the famous fish!**
